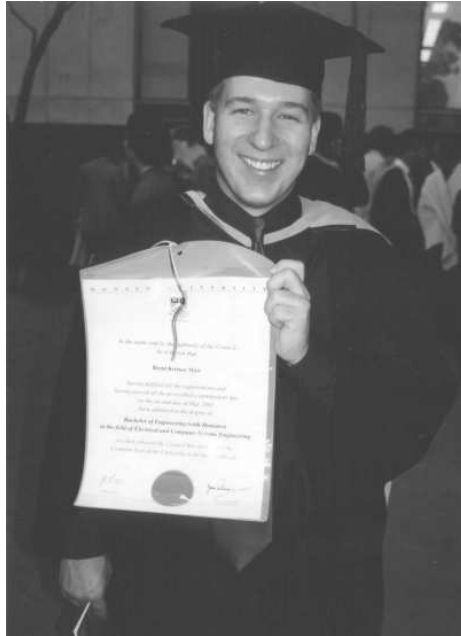


# DEAFM INDUSTRIES UPDATE

has promised the materials and Mobile Mission Maintenance here in Melbourne are considering sending a team to build it, so busy days are ahead.

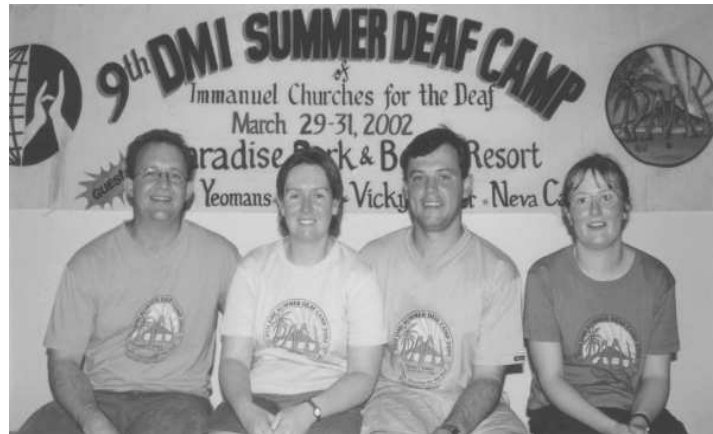
